It is important to wash my hands

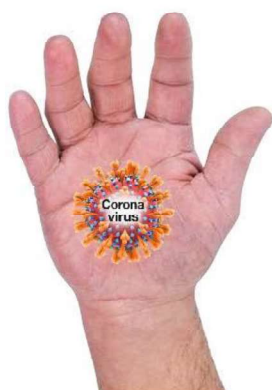


Washing my hands will help keep them clean of germs

Germs can make people sick



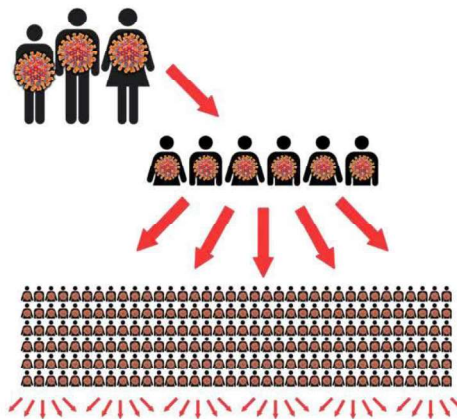
Germs can live on our hands
